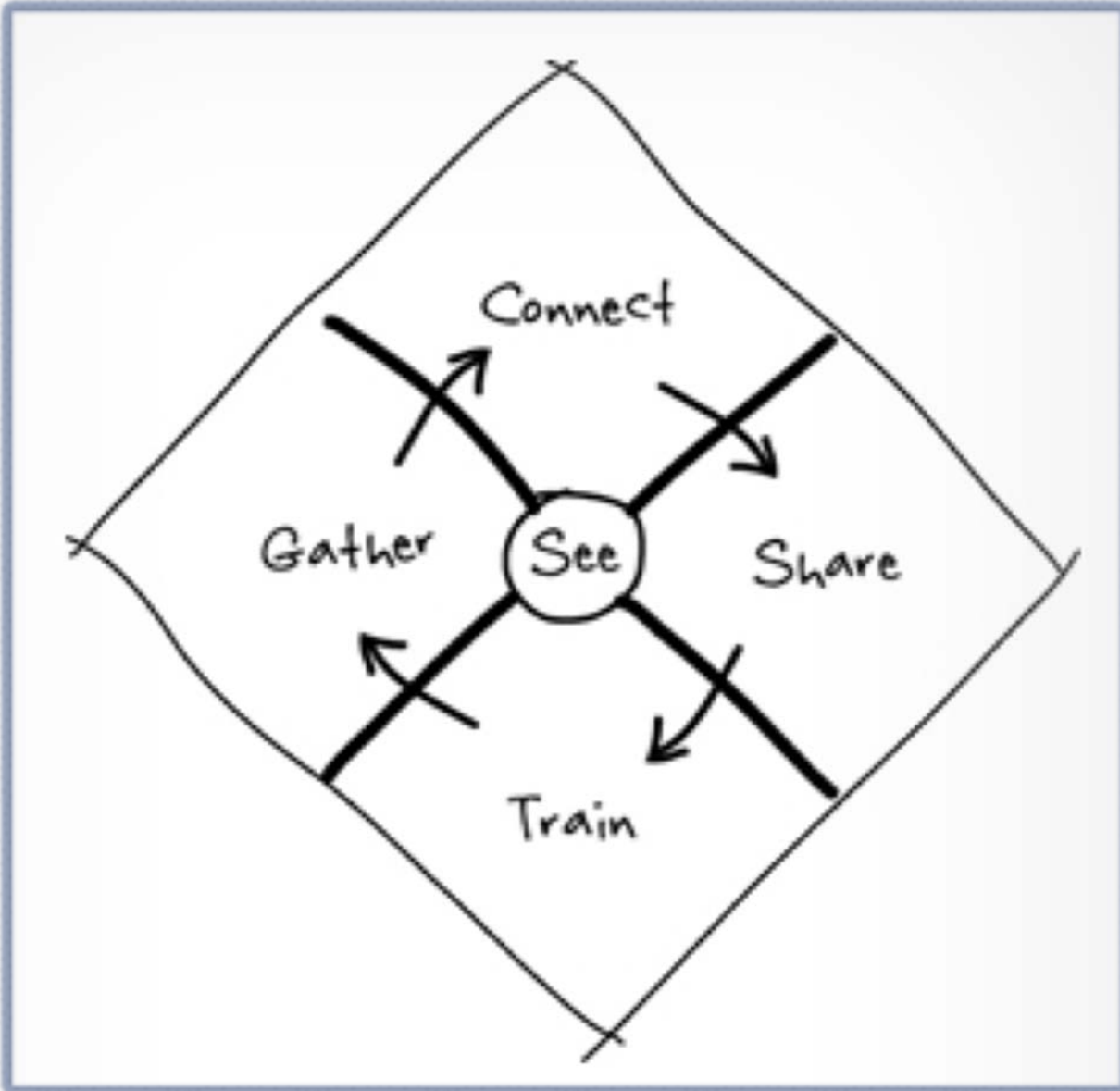

Commissioning Community (Acts 13:2-3) where we listen to the Holy Spirit’s leading to send people out to multiply disciples.



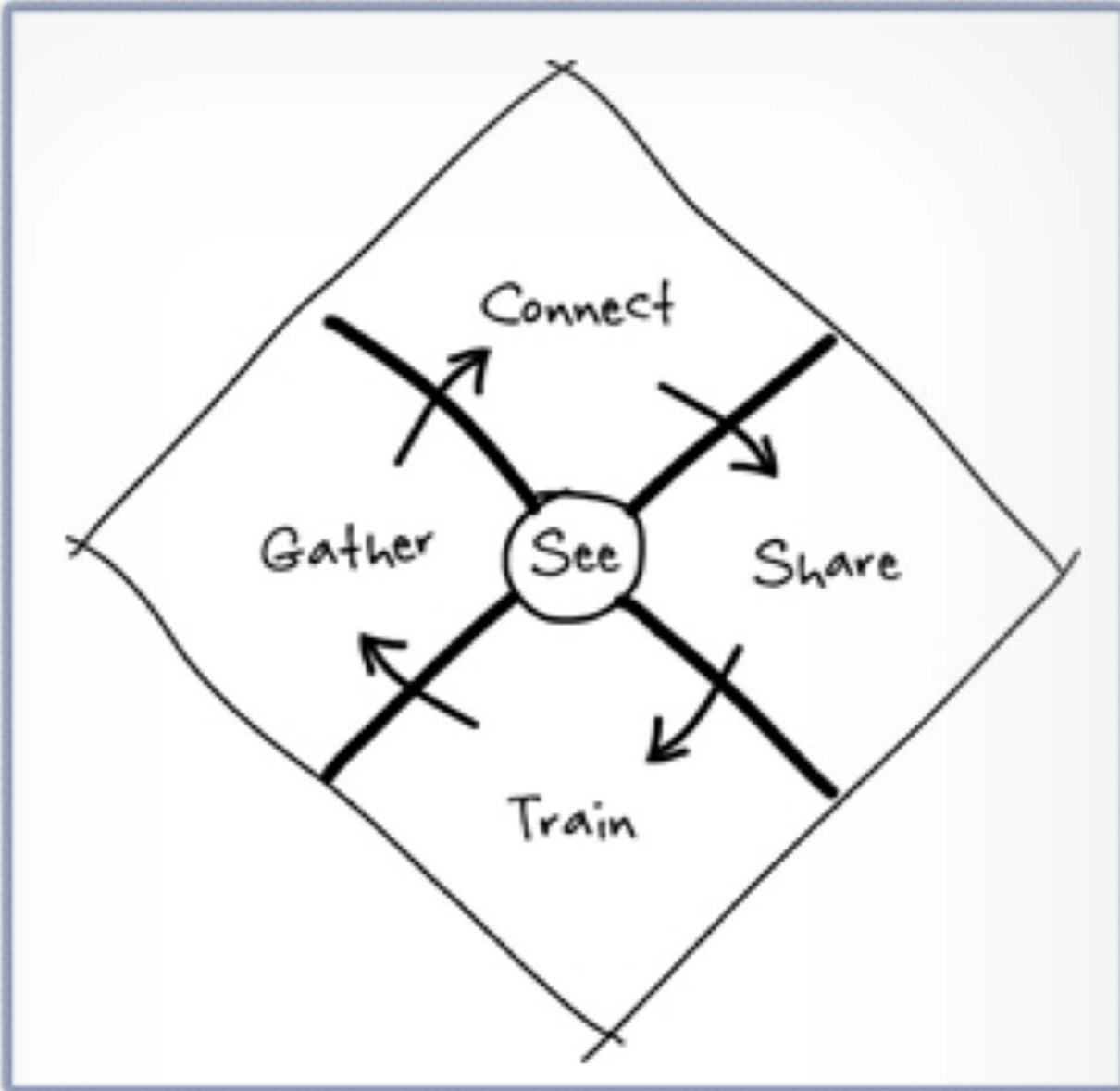
Evangelism isn't about winning an argument, it is about introducing people to Jesus!
